We are excited to announce, the first annual Arkansas Intercollegiate Choir (AIC) will convene at the Arkansas All State Music Convention, February 16 & 17, 2012! An intercollegiate choir has been a vision of the Arkansas ACDA for many years, and its concept will mirror that of the Arkansas Intercollegiate Band. AIC will begin with afternoon rehearsals on Thursday, February 16 (1 p.m.-5 p.m.) followed by rehearsal Friday morning (9a.m. – 12p.m.), and a Friday afternoon concert. The choir will perform quality, accessible literature with a superior clinician, who will be announce shortly. Tom Street, Executive Director of ArkCDA, has been a wonderful advocate for our cause, and has placed our Friday afternoon concert in the All State schedule so that each All State student will be able to hear the concert!

We strongly encourage each and every institution of higher education in Arkansas to send students to this enriching event! It will allow for students to sing a variety of literature with other college students from across the state, learn from other musicians, and continue our promotion of choral music!

Each college may send a balanced quartet (SATB) or octet (SSAATTBB), chosen by you. The cost will be \$15.00/student which will cover the costs of registration and music. Each college will be responsible for their own transportation, meals, and if applicable, lodging for Thursday evening.
