Singers who do not know their music may not be allowed to participate in the honor choir.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where will we stay? All members of the 2011 AR-ACDA Honor Choir will be responsible for making their own lodging arrangements. Hotel options and lodging rates will be provided to those who are chosen for the choir.

All Honor Choir Members will room with their chaperone(s). Teachers WILL NOT be allowed to room with their students, unless they are related.

Does each singer need a chaperone? YES

There must be a responsible adult above the age of 21, other than the student's choir director, for each singer in the 2011 AR-ACDA Honor Choirs. Each individual chaperone MAY BE RESPONSIBLE for more than one honor choir singer. CHOIR DIRECTORS MAY NOT BE THE OFFICIAL CHAPERONE.

Will there be a meal plan for the honor choir singers? NO

A dinner will be provided Monday, August 1 after the 1st rehearsal for the honor choir members. However, everyone is on his or her own for all other meals. There are many fast food as well as sit down restaurants on the same strip as the rehearsal area.

Can we send Purchase Order #'s or credit card #'s for fees? NO

The AR-ACDA Honor Choir is being organized by choral directors who volunteer their time. The organization is not equipped to handle purchase orders or credit cards. ALL PAYMENTS should be made using check or money order to AR-ACDA. PLEASE put the student(s) name in the memo blank for all payments, and submit payment with the appropriate forms. All payments, fees, and forms should be mailed to the honor choir coordinators.

What does a chaperone do?

Chaperones are responsible for their singers throughout the honor choir experience. At registration, chaperones will need to provide cell phone numbers where they can be reached in Hot Springs. Chaperones will also be asked to sign-up to attend rehearsals and other honor choir activities. Chaperones are responsible for enforcing the code of conduct and making sure their singers are on time for all rehearsals, activities and performances. Chaperones are also expected to enforce published "in room" and "lights out" times.
